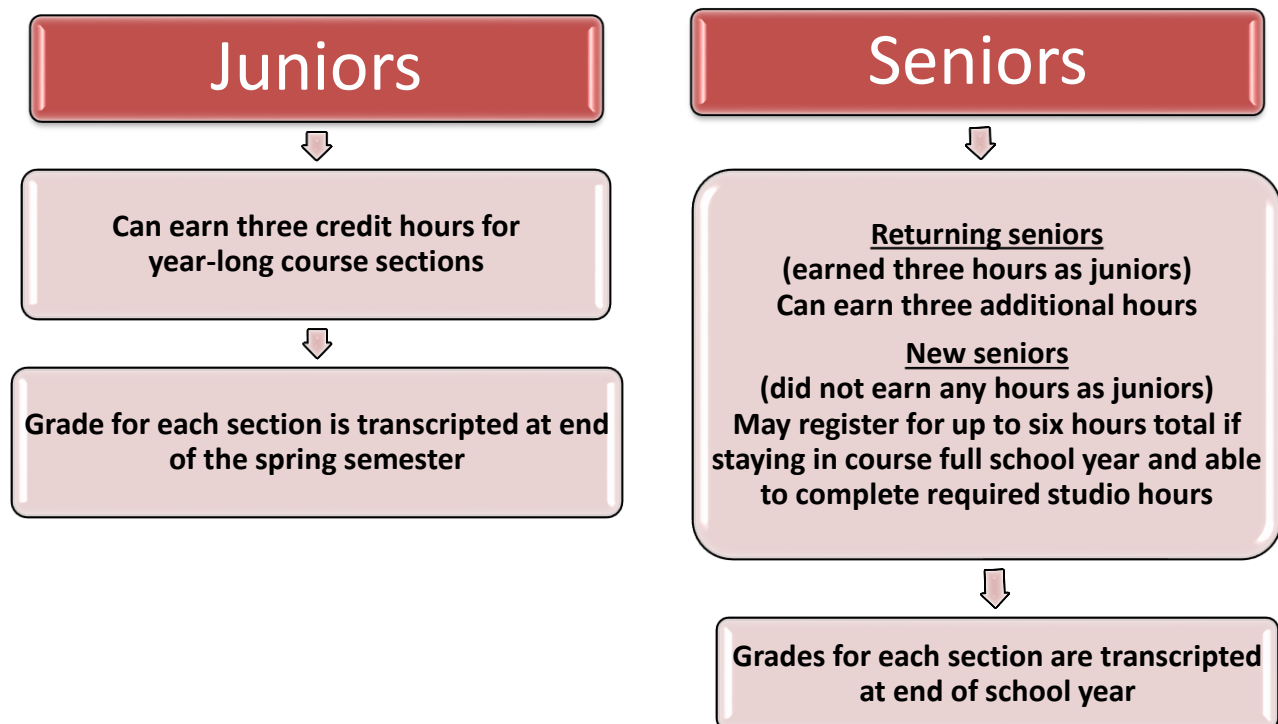




Radio/Television 150 Guide to Enrollment and Credit Hour Eligibility

The University of Southern Indiana (USI) course Radio/Television 150, Practicum in Broadcasting, is a one credit hour practicum course that can be taken multiple times, both by USI and CAP students. Enrolling in RTV 150 more than once allows students to continue building skills and learning different aspects of radio/television. A CAP student with a qualifying GPA may earn up to six hours of RTV 150 credit (one credit hour per section) during junior and senior years. The graphic below shows the different options for students in a CAP RTV 150 classroom.



Juniors can request three sections of RTV 150 for three credit hours on the fall CAP Student Permission Form. Returning seniors can request three additional sections of RTV 150 for three additional hours of RTV 150 on the fall CAP Student Permission Form. Each credit hour earned requires 50 studio hours.
