WORLD WAR II PRISONER OF WAR CHARLES C. HUPPERT WILL BRING COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS

Charles C. Huppert, an Evansville businessman and World War II pilot who helped engineer "The Great Escape" from a Nazi prisoner-of-war camp, will bring the Commencement address today.

Mr. Huppert was one of 600 captured allied airmen who used handmade tools

to construct three sophisticated tunnels, "Tom," "Dick," and "Harry," under the noses of German guards at Stalag Luft III in Sagan, Germany (now Zagan, Poland). Before the escape plan was enacted, the Nazis discovered "Tom" and Huppert and other Americans were transferred to another camp.

On March 24, 1944, 200 men planned to flee through "Harry." Only 76 escaped before the 77th was spotted by guards, and all but three were recaptured by the Nazis. Of those recaptured, 23 were returned to camps and 50 were executed in violation of the Geneva Convention. In February 1945, Mr. Huppert and other prisoners were forced into a two-week subzero death march from Sagan to Moosburg, near Munich. By the time they were liberated in April, Mr. Huppert had lost more than 100 pounds from his 6-feet, 210-pound frame.

A film about the brave men's plan, "The Great Escape" featuring Steve McQueen, was released in 1963. More recently, for its "Nova" series, the Public Broadcasting System (PBS) undertook the production of a documentary about the prison and

the famous plan of escape. Mr. Huppert was a consultant for the documentary, returning to Zagan in 2003, where he was reunited with two other former prisoners from the camp—one from Arizona and one from England.

Mr. Huppert was born in 1918 in Dale, Indiana, and graduated from Arsenal Tech High School in Indianapolis in 1936. The following year he traveled to Los Angeles, California, enrolled at University of California, Los Angeles, and worked in the movie industry as an electronics technician. Mr. Huppert then joined the Army Air Corps Reserve and became a civilian pilot.

In January 1942, he was called to active duty as a B-25 pilot and flew his plane from the United States to a British Air Base on the Suez Canal in Egypt. On April 26, 1943, while flying along the coast of Tunisia, he was shot down and taken prisoner by the Germans. After enduring several camps and the death march, he and other prisoners were liberated by the American 14th Armored Division on April 29, 1945.

In 1946, Mr. Huppert was separated from active duty as a lieutenant colonel and moved to Evansville, where he started Merchants Alarm Service, Inc. with his wife Betty Jean. He retired in 1982.

Mr. Huppert is a member of the Dale United Methodist Church, the Air Force Association, Aerospace Education Foundation, the Friends of the Air Force Academy Library, the Planetary Society, New York Academy of Sciences, and the Oregon Institute of Science and Medicine. He has maintained a lifelong interest in science and research.

In today's ceremony, Mr. Huppert will receive an honorary Doctor of Science degree.

TIMOTHY J. SCHIBIK WILL RECEIVE DISTINGUISHED PROFESSOR AWARD

Dr. Timothy J. Schibik, professor of economics, was chosen by his colleagues to receive the Integra Bank Distinguished Professor Award, given in recognition of significant achievement in teaching, scholarship, and service.

Dr. Schibik earned the Doctor of Philosophy degree in 1989 and

the Master of Arts in 1986 from West Virginia University. He also holds Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts degrees from Youngstown State University. Dr. Schibik joined the University of Southern Indiana in 1988 as assistant professor. He was promoted to associate professor in 1995 and full professor in 2001. He also has served as a member of the Graduate Faculty since 1988.

In addition to teaching both undergraduate and graduate economics courses, Dr. Schibik has been the director of the Center for Teaching and Learning Excellence at USI since fall 1999. From 1997-2002, he was coordinator of the Lilly Retention Initiatives project, overseeing a grant from the Lilly Endowment. An active consultant-evaluator for the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, he visits colleges and universities in the region to evaluate them for accreditation. Dr. Schibik also has been a systems appraiser for The Academic Quality Improvement Program of the Higher Learning Commission.

A respected leader in his field, Dr. Schibik is president of the Midwest Business Economics Association, which he also has served as program chair. He is a member of the Board of Directors of the Midwest Business Economics Association and the Advisory Board of the Midwest Business Administration Association. He has received the USI School of Business Teaching Award, Academic Advisor Recognition Award, and twice has received the Dean's Excellence in Teaching Award. The Indiana Association for Institutional Research has chosen him for its highest awards for a paper and a presentation. Dr. Schibik's research in economics and in pedagogy appears in many refereed journals and refereed paper presentations.


He has served the University on many committees and task forces, has been a member and chair of the Faculty Senate, and is chair of the University Promotions Committee. In addition, he has served on the Board of Directors for Historic Southern Indiana, an outreach program of the University.

A colleague who nominated Dr. Schibik for this award cited his commitment "to all facets of academic life, most notably excelling as a model collaborator, mentor, and colleague...exemplified by a constant enthusiasm for academic life."

Students call him an "awesome" teacher, conceding that his tests are difficult, but that he is enthusiastic and helpful, aiding in retaining class material.

As Distinguished Professor, Dr. Schibik will receive a grant from Integra Bank, will select a student to receive a scholarship in his name next year, and will deliver the Distinguished Professor Lecture during the next academic year.

SAMUEL J. TUCKER TO RECEIVE PRESIDENT'S MEDAL

The Student Affairs Committee of the Faculty Senate selected Samuel I. Tucker, a senior from Evansville, as this year's recipient of the President's Medal. He was chosen because of his commitment to academic excellence and his service to the University and the community. He will graduate magna cum laude with two degrees,

a Bachelor of Science in chemistry and a Bachelor of Arts in marketing.

Mr. Tucker has held the Robert F. and Florence R. Bernhardt Presidential Scholarship and the Bristol Myers Squibb National Merit Scholarship while attending USI. He was selected for the General Electric Plastics Company Chemistry Cooperative Education program, and for two summers he researched, created, and wrote new analytical procedures for trace chemical analysis and helped in development of Six Sigma-Award-Winning HPS7 Polycarbonate. He also has been a research chemist at USI and completed and presented five research projects at professional chemistry meetings. In spring 2002, he studied at the Warsaw School of Economics in Warsaw, Poland.

Among Mr. Tucker's many honors are recipient of the 2004 All-Campus Student Achievement Award and the 2001 American Chemical Society Indiana-Kentucky Border Section Sophomore Award for Excellence in Chemistry. He is a member of Alpha Chi and Sigma Zeta honors societies, Marketing Club, German Club, Geology Club, and American Chemical Society.

As a member of the USI men's tennis team, Mr. Tucker was named to the 2003-2004 All Great Lakes Valley Conference Academic Tennis Team and also was a Collegiate All-American Scholar in 2004. He is a member of the Rock Climbing Club and has been active in the USI intramural program, competing in basketball, bowling, flag football, volleyball, and euchre. He also has been a math tutor and a College Bowl participant.

Mr. Tucker's leadership has been evident in many aspects of campus life. He was appointed to the USI Board of Trustees by the governor of Indiana, serving from 2003 to the present. He has held several offices in the Student Government Association, including executive vice president, attorney general, administrative vice president for research and development, and representative for the Pott College of Science and Engineering. Mr. Tucker also has served on the Intercollegiate Athletics Board, the USI Student Affairs Committee, the Student Trustee Search Committee and other university-wide search committees. He is a frequent volunteer for community events, and is organizing the USI Student Athlete Habitat for Humanity Build.

Mr. Tucker is the son of William and Mary Tucker of Evansville. After graduation, Mr. Tucker plans to attend the University of Southern Mississippi to pursue a Ph.D. in Polymer Science and Engineering.

Presidential Medallion

During the Middle Ages, medallions signified membership in religious orders and guilds and, in the Renaissance, membership in elite orders of knighthood and prominence in government office. Today, colleges and universities strike medallions to commemorate important events and achievements. The University of Southern Indiana Presidential Medallion signifies the authority invested in the president.

Fabricated in bronze, the Presidential Medallion celebrates the 1995 inauguration of President H. Ray Hoops. At its center the bronze medallion bears a threeinch reproduction of the University seal, surrounded by a half-inch rim; on the back of the medallion are the names and dates of appointment of the University's presidents. During today's ceremony, a replica of the Presidential Medallion will be presented to Samuel J. Tucker. This is the highest honor given to a graduating senior.

University Seal

The University seal bears the University's colors—red, white, and blue—with gold. The shield signifies the importance of higher education in defending citizens against ignorance. Between the two banners carrying the University's name appear a band and an open book bound together by the torch of knowledge. In the band, rays of light emanate simultaneously from a rising sun, symbolizing the young University, and from the torch, symbolizing the light of knowledge and the passion for scholarship. Trees on either side of the flame suggest not only the University's

pastoral southern Indiana setting but also life, growth, continuity.

Beneath this band, an open book emphasizes the importance of teaching and learning; academia populi and academia populo indicate that the University of Southern Indiana is a scholarly academy founded and supported by the people, for the people. Finally, the laurel branches to the right and left of the book represent victory: the light of learning overcomes the darkness of ignorance.

University Mace

In the Middle Ages, bodyguards of French and English monarchs carried ceremonial maces. Later, the mace became an important symbol of office in civil processions and academic pageantry; at the University of Southern Indiana, the Grand Marshal, a distinguished member of the faculty, carries the mace.

A replica of the walking cane of Richard Owen (1810-1890) serves as the centerpiece of the University mace. A respected geologist and professor of natural science at Indiana University, Owen became the first president of Purdue University. He was a son of Robert Owen (1771-1858), the Welsh industrialist who established New Harmony, Indiana, as a center for education and enlightened social reform in the early 1800s. The 32-inch-tall, wooden cane was presented to Richard Owen in 1874 and, through the generosity of his descendant Kenneth D. Owen, served as the Grand Marshal's staff until the mace was fabricated for the University's first Presidential Inauguration in 1995.

Designed and fabricated by Nicholas Logsdon of Indianapolis, the University mace encloses a replica of the Owen cane and is goldplated. At the top, above the cane's golden head, an open orb holds a replica of the University seal. The free-flowing design of the orb symbolizes the interrelationships among all academic disciplines. Below the cane's tip are three golden rings engraved with the names and appointment dates of the University presidents. A finial at the tip of the cane bears the names of Kenneth Dale Owen, Jane Blaffer Owen, and James A. Sanders, donors of the mace.

Designed and created by alumnus Kenny Fisher '77, the replica of the cane and the base are made of walnut from the Owen mansion built in New Harmony during the 1830s. The University mace is cared for by Paul F. Groeninger, Master Jeweler.

Gonfalons

Gonfalons, ceremonial flags, originated in the Middle Ages for military and civil processions. They often appeared beneath the steel head of a knight's lance. In Italy, gonfalons designated Italian republics; and the bearer, or gonfalonier, served as chief magistrate or held other high office. The University of Southern Indiana gonfalons represent each of the academic units of the institution, and they are carried by deans or department heads. Gonfalon colors derive from traditional colors for academic disciplines in each college. Our commencement gonfalons come as a gift from the USI Bookstore.

COMMENCEMENT TRADITIONS

Academic Dress

The academic costume dates from medieval days when university students wore woolen and fur garments for warmth in damp and drafty buildings. Most of those studying were clerics in holy orders; they wore a cloak to which was attached a hood that could be pulled up to cover their tonsured heads. Simplified today, the costume serves to remind us that its wearer is a member of an ancient and venerable profession; it also indicates by its color and design the wearer's degree and the institution by which the degree was conferred.

In the United States, black has been the traditional color for academic gowns, but some institutions authorize holders of their doctorates to wear colors of the institution. The bachelor's gown is distinguished by its long, open sleeves; the master's by its closed, slitted sleeves; the doctor's by its full sleeves trimmed with bands of velvet, which may be black or a color denoting the field in which the degree was taken.

The mortarboard cap, proper for all degrees, is black. Tassels, usually black, are worn over the left front quarter of the cap. Holders of the doctorate may wear tassels of gold thread.

Academic hoods vary in length according to the degree attained and are lined with the colors of the institution by which the

degree was granted. The honorary doctoral hoods of the University of Southern Indiana are black, lined with blue satin with red satin chevrons. They are edged with white velvet.

Alumni Association Pins

Graduates in today's ceremony are receiving lapel pins with the University logo as a gift from the University of Southern Indiana Alumni Association.

Baccalaureate Scholarship Honors

The baccalaureate degree candidate graduating with the highest scholarship index is graduated summa cum laude. Baccalaureate students graduating with a scholarship index of 3.80 or higher are graduated magna cum laude. Those with a scholarship index between 3.60 and 3.80 are graduated cum laude. These achievements are set forth on the individual diplomas. Honor students can be recognized in the Commencement Exercises by colored stoles and tassels. Gold indicates summa cum laude: red, magna cum laude; and blue, cum laude.

Because students enrolled in master's degree programs are expected to maintain a minimum grade-point average of 3.0, and most achieve much higher levels, scholarship honors at Commencement are given only to baccalaureate students.

University Honors Scholars

The designation of University Honors Scholar is awarded to students who successfully complete the Honors Program. They can be recognized in today's ceremony by the white honor cords worn with their regalia.

Photography During Ceremony

A commercial photographer is taking photographs of each graduate as he/she shakes hands on stage. Each graduate will receive a proof from which duplicates can be ordered. Family members who wish to take still or video photographs during the ceremony are asked to use the restricted area on the floor. Security guards will ask those who block aisles in the stands or occupy the area behind the stage to move. Your cooperation ensures the dignity of the Commencement ceremony.

Commemorative Video

In response to requests from graduates and families, a high-quality commemorative videotape of today's ceremony is being produced by the USI Office of Instructional Technology Services in cooperation with the USI Alumni Association. The tape includes the entire ceremony, depicting each graduate receiving a diploma cover, as well as candid behind-the-scenes shots.
