# JEAN M. LEMMON WILL DELIVER COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS

Entrepreneur, author, innovator, leader, award-winning journalist—all auspiciously describe Jean LemMon, today's Commencement speaker.

Ms. LemMon's talents stem from her two true passions, writing and art.

Born in Duluth, Minnesota, Ms. LemMon

grew up cultivating her love of art, theatre, music, and writing, making her mark early in high school as an author and contributing to the school newspaper. She entered the University of Minnesota at Duluth and continued to hone and develop her writing and artistic skills. While at UMD, she wrote for the fine arts magazine and was hired by the university to design and execute stage sets for school productions. In recognition of her outstanding talents, she was accepted into the art, theater, and journalism honorary fraternities and was included in *Who's Who Among Students in Colleges and Universities*. She graduated from UMD in 1954 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in art and an English minor.

Following graduation, she continued to blend her interests in writing and art, working for Duluth television stations, designing sets for local programs, and writing both advertising and promotional copy for area publications.

In 1961, Ms. LemMon joined the Meredith Corporation as an associate editor of *Better Homes and Gardens* magazine. She then moved to the leadership position in the women's department at *Successful Farming* magazine, another Meredith holding.

Meredith (www.meredith.com) is one of the nation's leading media and marketing companies with businesses centering on magazine and book publishing, television broadcasting, integrated marketing, and interactive media. The Meredith Publishing Group features 26 subscription magazines - including Better Homes and Gardens, Family Circle, Ladies' Home Journal, MORE,

Parents, Fitness, and American Baby - and approximately 200 special interest publications. Meredith owns 14 television stations, including properties in top-25 markets such as Atlanta, Phoenix, and Portland.

After seven years with Meredith, Ms. LemMon started her own freelance and design business, writing for the Maytag Company, Owens Corning Fiberglass, Armstrong World Industries, and Meredith. Of particular pride to Ms. LemMon is her engagement by the Diocese of Des Moines to write the official program and commemorative book for Pope John Paul II's visit to rural America in 1979.

In 1986, Ms. LemMon returned to Meredith to lead the crafts division of *Better Homes and Gardens* magazine and was promoted to editor in chief of *Country Home* magazine. *Country Home* is a publication with over eight million readers, dedicated to the art and science of making a home a reflection of the owner's creative passions, styles, and interests. After a successful term as editor in chief, Ms. LemMon returned to *Better Homes and Gardens*, the signature publication of Meredith, as editor in chief, the first woman in the magazine's history to hold the senior position.

Applauded by her peers for her laudable talents and leadership in the field of journalism and interior design, she is the recipient of four national awards, holds membership in Mensa, The American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers, and the Sons of Norway. She is a past board member of the Board of Trustees of the Vesterheim Norwegian American Museum in Decorah, Iowa.

Retired from her post as editor in chief, Ms. LemMon currently lives in Des Moines, Iowa, active in her church and library.

It is a tradition at the University of Southern Indiana to present the Commencement speaker with an honorary degree. With the conferral of the honorary Doctor of Letters degree, the University of Southern Indiana celebrates Ms. LemMon's dedication to excellence and welcomes her today.

# THREE CIVIC LEADERS TO BE RECOGNIZED

D. Patrick and Rosemary O'Daniel keep their family and its traditions at the center of their lives. Ioe and Marie O'Daniel. parents of Patrick, were instrumental in the development of the University of Southern Indiana. Mr. and Mrs. O'Daniel have continued that commitment to the University. The O'Daniel Leadership Academy was formed in honor of the late Joseph O'Daniel, and Patrick and Rosemary have extended their support to the program.

The parents of five children and grandparents of 13, Mr. and Mrs. O'Daniel value education. Mr. O'Daniel attended the University of Notre Dame, graduating *cum laude* in 1959. Mrs. O'Daniel attended Barat College in Lake Forest, Illinois, and both O'Daniels continued studies at the University of Evansville.

Mr. O'Daniel is the president and CEO of O'Daniel Ranes Inc., retired owner and CEO of D-Patrick, Inc., and manager of O'Daniel Automotive Associates. He has held offices and memberships in professional automobile associations at the local, state, and national level.

He is an advisory board member of the University of Southern Indiana Foundation, board member of the University of Evansville President's Club, and a member of the Evansville Chamber of Commerce.

He is active in the Reitz Home Preservation Society, the Evansville Philharmonic Society, Christ the King Catholic Church, and the Evansville Rotary Club.

Mrs. O'Daniel ensures that the family's commitment to the community is a true partnership as she brings her enthusiasm and expertise to bear on the boards of several organizations. She was the first "In the Pink" chair of the Evansville Komen Race for the Cure and the chair of the BMW Drive for the Cure. She also has served on the board and in leadership positions for St. Mary's Hospital, Harper School PTA, Junior League of Evansville, and the Evansville Museum of Arts and Science.

Through the USI Foundation, the O'Daniels have supported Presidential Scholarships, The New Harmony Theatre, Society for Arts and Humanities, Varsity Club, USI Annual Fund, Historic New Harmony, and are longtime members of the USI President's Associates.

In today's ceremony, each will receive the honorary Doctor of Laws degree. Bettie G. Engelbrecht has been a pioneer in Indiana broadcasting and is recognized for that leadership today, as she receives an honorary Doctor of Laws degree.

A native of Evansville, Mrs. Engelbrecht took a business course at Lockyear Business College following her graduation from Bosse High School in 1937. She attended two years at Purdue University before transferring to the University of Evansville,

where she completed her Bachelor of Arts degree.

Mrs. Engelbrecht embarked on a teaching career at Centennial Grade School, teaching physical education. During that same year she married John Engelbrecht, a member of the communications unit of the United States Navy. His post took them to California.


John Engelbrecht was founder and president of the South Central Communications. After nearly 40 years of marriage, Mr. Engelbrecht died, leaving leadership in the company in the hands of his 26-year-old son, with Mrs. Engelbrecht to guide and support the development of a company that today contains WIKY-FM and WROZ in Evansville, WZEZ in Nashville, Tennessee, WEZK-FM and WTVK-TV in Knoxville, Tennessee, and nine MUZAK franchises. South Central Communications employs over 500 people.

In the earliest years of the communications business, Mrs. Engelbrecht's teaching income helped support the fledgling radio station. Her dedication and influence is at work in South Central Communications, where she serves as corporate secretary.

Mrs. Engelbrecht was instrumental in South Central's donation 25 years ago of its first station, at AM frequency 820, to the University of Southern Indiana. AM 820 is broadcasting today as WSWI. The station provides USI students with a hands-on experience operating, producing, and programming the AM station on campus. Operating as a nonprofit entity, the student station follows Federal Communications Commission guidelines and regulations.

Mrs. Engelbrecht has been actively involved in her community. She serves on The USI Foundation Board of Directors and she supports the New Harmony Theatre, which is produced by USI. Mrs. Engelbrecht was honored with the Special Recognition Award by the USI Alumni Association in 1996.

## INTEGRA BANK DISTINGUISHED PROFESSOR PAUL K. DOSS

Dr. Paul K. Doss, associate professor of geology, was chosen by his colleagues to receive the Integra Bank Distinguished Professor Award, given in recognition of significant achievement in teaching, scholarship, and service.

Paul Kenneth Doss holds a bachelor of science degree in geology from Indiana

University Purdue University Indianapolis, and a master's degree and doctorate in geology from Northern Illinois University. He has served on the faculty of the University of Southern Indiana in the Pott College of Science and Engineering since 1997, holding the position of chair of the department of geology and physics from 1998-2006.

His leadership at USI includes roles as a member of the USI New Harmony Task Force; co-chair, Mission and Integrity committee for the self-study report to the Higher Learning Commission; Program Review Assessment Committee; USI Foundation Board of Directors; member and vice chair of Faculty Senate; and chair of the Pott College Environmental Science Program Development Committee. Additionally, he is the author of numerous publications, papers, and technical reports.

To quote a colleague, Dr. Doss is deserving of this honor because of his ability to "merge his research with his teaching and service." Bringing real-world application into the classroom is a fundamental element of Dr. Doss' classes, as he shares his insights and experiences from a variety of professional experiences and services across the country.

From 2000-2001, Dr. Doss held the position of chief geologist at Yellowstone National Park. During his time at Yellowstone he was instrumental in establishing a wide variety of educational projects including several exhibits on park geology at two visitor centers, the development

of a major film on the hydrothermal features of the park, several geology-related wayside exhibits, and revision of the educational curriculum. His expertise was invaluable in the Division of Interpretation to improve the public's understanding of the geologic context of Yellowstone National Park, and his scholarship enabled the park to bring deeper meaning and value to park visitors. A letter of recommendation from the Department of the Interior, National Park Service acclaims that "few would warrant our unequivocal enthusiasm more than Dr. Paul Doss."

Closer to home, Dr. Doss has lent his considerable talent and expertise to the Indiana University Geologic Field Station, the U.S. Geological Survey in Indianapolis, the physical and chemical hydrogeology of the Inglefield aquifer in Vanderburgh County, and the hydrogeology and geochemistry of constructed wetlands in Warrick County.


He has been instrumental in securing grants to benefit his work with his colleagues and students in Indiana, Kentucky, Alabama, and Montana.

He is the recipient of the 2006 Geological Society of America's Outstanding Research Award, the USI Pott College of Science and Engineering Barnett Research Award, and the 2001 Special Achievement Award presented by the United States Department of the Interior, National Park Service.

As the Integra Bank Distinguished Professor, Dr. Doss will receive a grant from Integra Bank, will select a student to receive a scholarship in his name next year, will deliver a Distinguished Professor Lecture during the next academic year, and will bring the Commencement address at the Fall Commencement in December 2007.

The University is proud to celebrate the work of Dr. Doss and his significant impact in the classroom, on campus, in the community, and across the country.

# CRAIG T. FEHRMAN WILL RECEIVE PRESIDENT'S MEDAL

The Student Affairs Committee of the Faculty Senate selected Mr. Craig Fehrman of Lawrenceburg, Indiana, as this year's recipient of the President's Medal. He was chosen because of his commitment to academic excellence and his service to the University. He will graduate magna cum laude, with a Bachelor

of Arts degree in English and psychology.

Mr. Fehrman's academic excellence and leadership is reflected in the numerous awards, scholarships, and honors he has received during his time at the University of Southern Indiana. He is the recipient of the 2006 Trustees Distinguished Merit Award, the 2006 Sigma Tau Delta Mu Phi Professional Engagement Award, and an SGA travel grant to attend the International Edmund Spencer Conference at the University of Toronto. Additionally he is listed in Who's Who Among College and University Students, and he was the recipient of a scholarship to attend the RopeWalk Writer's Retreat in 2005. He was the first place winner of the campus-wide essay contest "Why Americans Don't Read" in 2004, the annual departmental scholarship, and the annual merit scholarship from Antioch Corporation.

His work in the classroom has been touted by numerous members of faculty as "the best student they have ever had the pleasure of teaching." With both English and psychology majors, Mr. Fehrman's ability to demonstrate success is seemingly without limits as he moves from statistics and neurobiology to Edmund Spencer and Emily Dickinson. A self-described Renaissance man, Mr. Fehrman's love of learning and quest for knowledge is reflected in his careful and high caliber work, earning the respect of his classmates, faculty members, and administration of the College of Liberal Arts.

Outside of the classroom, Mr. Fehrman has served for three years as a resident assistant and provided leadership on a wide range of Residence Life committees, including Residence Hall Council and the Web site committee. He has represented USI at seven different conferences or panels including the National Undergraduate Literature Conference and the Medieval Forum at Plymouth State University. A 45-page manuscript, an extension of his senior thesis, is forthcoming in the Chaucer Review, an international peer-reviewed literary/historical journal, as is the publication of several short reference articles and book reviews. Mr. Fehrman has served as a writing tutor in USI's Academic Skills, the online editor and theatre reviewer for The Shield, an intern for the Emily Dickinson International Society Bulletin, and a member of the dean's Student Advisory Council. He is an active member of the Recreation and Fitness Center's Miler's Club and a participant in a number of intramural activities.

Beyond the University, Mr. Fehrman has shared his time and talents as a counselor and teacher at Southeastern Indiana youth camp and a tutor at IMPACT Ministries in downtown Evansville. Additionally he is a member of the worship band at his church and has moved from camper to camp counselor for their summer programs.

The son of Charles and Deborah Fehrman, Craig is an applicant to a number of the country's most prestigious graduate schools, seeking a Ph.D. in Literature. With several acceptances in hand, Mr. Fehrman hopes to spend many years in the classroom, first as a student in a doctoral program and then as a professor seeking to give to his future students what he was the recipient of during his time at the University of Southern Indiana—mentoring, insight, passionate teaching, and an environment that motivated him to explore, learn, and reach for more. As he looks to bring his past together with his future, he is grounded by a single principle: the import and inspiration of the student/professor exchange. It is a dynamic of which he aspires to always be a part.

Other finalists for the President's Medal are Nathanael L. Atkinson, Lauren C. Fultz, Jason Goodwin, and Elizabeth TenBrook.

The President's Medal is the highest honor presented by the University to a student. As is University tradition, Mr. Fehrman joins the Distinguished Professor, honorary degree recipients, senior administration, and Board of Trustees on the platform for today's ceremony.



#### COMMENCEMENT TRADITIONS

#### Presidential Medallion

During the Middle Ages, medallions signified membership in religious orders and guilds and, in the Renaissance, membership in elite orders of knighthood and prominence in government office. Today, colleges and universities strike medallions to commemorate important events and achievements. The University of Southern Indiana Presidential Medallion signifies the authority invested in the president.

Fabricated in bronze, the Presidential Medallion celebrates the 1995 inauguration of President H. Ray Hoops. At its center the bronze medallion bears a threeinch reproduction of the University seal, surrounded by a half-inch rim; on the back of the medallion are the names and dates of appointment of the University's presidents. During today's ceremony, a replica of the Presidential Medallion will be presented to Craig T. Fehrman. This is the highest honor given to a graduating senior.

## University Seal

The University seal bears the University's colors—red, white, and blue—with gold. The shield signifies the importance of higher education in defending citizens against ignorance. Between the two banners carrying the University's name appear a band and an open book bound together by the torch of knowledge. In the band, rays of light emanate simultaneously from a rising sun, symbolizing the young University, and from the torch, symbolizing the light of knowledge and the passion for scholarship. Trees on either side of the flame suggest not only the University's

pastoral southern Indiana setting but also life, growth, continuity.

Beneath this band, an open book emphasizes the importance of teaching and learning; academia populi and academia populo indicate that the University of Southern Indiana is a scholarly academy founded and supported by the people, for the people. Finally, the laurel branches to the right and left of the book represent victory: the light of learning overcomes the darkness of ignorance.

### University Mace

In the Middle Ages, bodyguards of French and English monarchs carried ceremonial maces. Later, the mace became an important symbol of office in civil processions and academic pageantry; at the University of Southern Indiana, the Grand Marshal, a distinguished member of the faculty, carries the mace.

A replica of the walking cane of Richard Owen (1810-1890) serves as the centerpiece of the University mace. A respected geologist and professor of natural science at Indiana University, Owen became the first president of Purdue University. He was a son of Robert Owen (1771-1858), the Welsh industrialist who established New Harmony, Indiana, as a center for education and enlightened social reform in the early 1800s. The 32-inch-tall, wooden cane was presented to Richard Owen in 1874 and, through the generosity of his descendant Kenneth D. Owen, served as the Grand Marshal's staff until the mace was fabricated for the University's first Presidential Inauguration in 1995.

Designed and fabricated by Nicholas Logsdon of Indianapolis, the University mace encloses a replica of the Owen cane and is goldplated. At the top, above the cane's golden head, an open orb holds a replica of the University seal. The free-flowing design of the orb symbolizes the interrelationships among all academic disciplines. Below the cane's tip are three golden rings engraved with the names and appointment dates of the University presidents. A finial at the tip of the cane bears the names of Kenneth Dale Owen, Jane Blaffer Owen, and James A. Sanders, donors of the mace.

Designed and created by alumnus Kenny Fisher '77, the replica of the cane and the base are made of walnut from the Owen mansion built in New Harmony during the 1830s. The University mace is cared for by Paul F. Groeninger, Master Jeweler.

#### Gonfalons

Gonfalons, ceremonial flags, originated in the Middle Ages for military and civil processions. They often appeared beneath the steel head of a knight's lance. In Italy, gonfalons designated Italian republics; and the bearer, or gonfalonier, served as chief magistrate or held other high office. The University of Southern Indiana gonfalons represent each of the academic units of the institution, and they are carried by deans or department heads. Gonfalon colors derive from traditional colors for academic disciplines in each college. The University's commencement gonfalons are a gift from the USI Bookstore.

#### Academic Dress

The academic costume dates from medieval days when university students wore woolen and fur garments for warmth in damp and drafty buildings. Most of those studying were clerics in holy orders; they wore a cloak to which was attached a hood that could be pulled up to cover their tonsured heads. Simplified today, the costume serves to remind us that its wearer is a member of an ancient and venerable profession; it also indicates by its color and design the wearer's degree and the institution by which the degree was conferred.

In the United States, black has been the traditional color for academic gowns, but some institutions authorize holders of their doctorates to wear colors of the institution. The bachelor's gown is distinguished by its long, open sleeves; the master's by its closed, slitted sleeves; the doctor's by its full sleeves trimmed with bands of velvet, which may be black or a color denoting the field in which the degree was taken.

The mortarboard cap, proper for all degrees, is black. Tassels, usually black, are worn over the left front quarter of the cap. Holders of the doctorate may wear tassels of gold thread.

Academic hoods vary in length according to the degree attained and are lined with the colors of the institution by which the

degree was granted. The honorary doctoral hoods of the University of Southern Indiana are black, lined with blue satin with red satin chevrons. They are edged with white velvet.

#### Alumni Association Pins

Graduates in today's ceremony are receiving lapel pins with the University logo as a gift from the University of Southern Indiana Alumni Association.

## Baccalaureate Scholarship Honors

The baccalaureate degree candidate graduating with the highest scholarship index is graduated summa cum laude. Baccalaureate students graduating with a scholarship index of 3.80 or higher are graduated magna cum laude. Those with a scholarship index between 3.60 and 3.80 are graduated cum laude. These achievements are set forth on the individual diplomas. Honor students can be recognized in the Commencement Exercises by colored stoles and tassels. Gold indicates summa cum laude; red, magna cum laude; and blue, cum laude.

Because students enrolled in master's degree programs are expected to maintain a minimum grade-point average of 3.0, and most achieve much higher levels, scholarship honors at Commencement are given only to baccalaureate students.

### University Honors Scholars

The designation of University Honors Scholar is awarded to students who successfully complete the Honors Program. They can be recognized in today's ceremony by the white honor cords worn with their regalia.

## Photography During Ceremony

A commercial photographer is taking photographs of each graduate as he/she shakes hands on stage. Each graduate will receive a proof from which duplicates can be ordered. Family members who wish to take still or video photographs during the ceremony are asked to use the restricted area on the floor. Security guards will ask those who block aisles in the stands or occupy the area behind the stage to move. Your cooperation ensures the dignity of the Commencement ceremony.

#### Commemorative DVD

In response to requests from graduates and families, a high-quality commemorative DVD of today's ceremony is being produced by the USI Office of Instructional Technology Services in cooperation with the USI Alumni Association.
