

# **Priority Registration Starts**

All students will soon begin registering for the Spring 2025 semester. Priority Registration allows eligible students to select courses prior to the beginning of the term. Students are encouraged to register at their earliest opportunity. Listed below is important information to ensure you schedule your classes successfully.

# **How to Check Holds**

To view your account holds, go to DegreeWorks (it looks like a graduation cap) under your Eagle Apps. Any holds will be listed on the top right corner of the page. You cannot register for classes until all your account holds are removed.

DegreeWorks offers many tools for advisors and students to track progress toward degree completion (audit), develop semester-by-semester course selections (plans), determine progress toward a different degree program ("what if" audit), and determine a potential grade point average (GPA calculator) based on certain criteria.

#### **Schedule Planner**

Schedule Planner streamlines online registration and helps students build their ideal class schedule. It integrates with DegreeWorks and is accessible from both PC and mobile devices. Schedule Planner allows you to add desired courses and see various schedule possibilities for the next semester.
