

"Because We Like It" Dowhie Collection Exhibited at USI through September 7



On display in the McCutchan Art Center/Pace Galleries at USI, you will see 118 ceramic, mixed media, and woven sculptures and vessels, prints, paintings, drawings, and jewelry--all from over 40 years of collecting art around the globe. These remarkable works belong to Lenny and Anne '83 Dowhie. And on Thursday, September 4, during a public reception (6 – 8 p.m.), the Dowhies will present a short talk at 6:30 p.m. about their collection.

Including works by major American and international artists, the exhibit falls into four sections: contemporary ceramic art, contemporary ceramic cups, works by family members and former students, two-dimensional works.

The Dowhies moved to Evansville in 1978. Lenny led in developing the ceramics curriculum and planning the ceramics center, named in February 2014 The Lenny and Anne Dowhie Ceramics Studio. He retired from USI in 2011 after 33 years of teaching; Anne Dowhie retired from EVSC in 2013 after 30 years of teaching.
