Student Rights and Responsibilities: A Code of Student Behavior

 - *Emergency Suspension:* A student may be temporarily and immediately suspended, pending a hearing, when the student's actions or threats of action poses a threat to themselves or to others, or to the University's educational mission or property or to the health or safety of University community members. No hearing will be required before the emergency suspension is imposed; however, a review of the emergency suspension will be held with the five (5) working days following the notification. The adjudication process will proceed in a timely manner.
