Admitted Student Task List

The Admitted Student Task List provides a comprehensive list of tasks a new student needs to complete prior to beginning classes at USI. You will access your personalized Task List on myUSI.

Submit Final Transcripts

Students must submit final high school transcripts and final college transcripts if applicable. Official transcripts must be sent from the institution(s) attended directly to <u>Undergraduate Admissions</u>.

Certified e-transcripts can be emailed to enroll@usi.edu; paper copies should be mailed to Undergraduate Admissions, 8600 University Blvd, Evansville, IN 47712.

College Student Inventory

All new freshmen are expected to complete the College Student Inventory (CSI). It will take about 20 minutes to complete. This questionnaire is an opportunity to share your background and thoughts on a variety of topics. Your responses to this questionnaire will allow us to connect you with services and assist you in reaching your goals.

This task will be marked off on your Admitted Student Task List 48 to72 hours after you have completed the inventory.

You will need your USI email and Student ID to begin the questionnaire.

Check Your Financial Aid

It is important that you check your financial aid for any information or documents that may still need to be submitted. Follow these steps:

- Log on to myUSI at portal.usi.edu.
- Select the Self-Service Icon (blue/gray file folders)
- Select Financial Aid

Register Your Vehicle

Academic Advisors

AP Scores

Advanced Placement (AP) exams are one form of nationally-recognized standardized examinations for which USI will grant eligible credit.

Eligible credit is granted based off of the qualifying AP Exam scores received on official AP score reports.

In order to be considered official, a score report/transcript must be submitted directly to USI from the organization that administers the exam. In most cases this is College Board.

2024 AP exam scores will be available starting July 8 at College Board. Make sure you have them set to be sent to USI, so we may issue appropriate credit.

Are you registered for Fall 2024 classes?

If you are not, take action today to set up an appointment to be advised and registered for classes. You can do that in the Admitted Student Task List or call us at 812-465-7167 for assistance. You don't want to wait for August Orientation, see your advisor in person or by Zoom and figure out your fall schedule.
