

USI RETIREES ORGANIZATION TURNS 10!

The annual business meeting of the USI Retirees was held on November 18, 2021, and featured a celebration of the 10th anniversary of the group. The gathering included recognition of the founding members and past presidents of the organization. Let's take a look back!

- Initial retiree organization created in 1998. Joanie Jost was chair of the first group, they only met for a short period of time.
- A second attempt at a retiree organization began in 2007. Sherrianne Standley and Sherry Darrell spearheaded the organization of the group with the support of the USI Foundation.
- Early activities were spring luncheons each year 2008-2010. The annual summer receptions began in 2010.
- The twice-yearly we-are-eatingpizza-not-going-to-semesterlaunching-meetings became must-attends.
- Events and excursions have included canoeing, visiting parks and museums, attending theatre/musical performances,



- The official birthdate of USI Retirees is March 11, 2011. The first president was Ed Jones. A list of charter members as well as a list of all past presidents can be found on the USI Retirees website.
- In 2011 there were 187 active retirees, now there are
- The average retiree served ISUE/USI for 22 years.
- The longest service record is held by Martha Niemeier with 47.6 years.
- The person retired the longest is Wanda Hibbitts, now 100 years old, with 34 years. In honor of Wanda's milestone birthday, alumni and friends from the Romain College of Business were invited to make a gift to the Wanda B. Hibbitts Accounting Scholarship Endowment.
- Eighty-five percent of USI retirees/spouses contribute to USI. To date, retirees have contributed over \$10.6 million. Many have established estate gifts as well.
- Retirees have participated on planning groups, marketing focus groups, alumni relations development projects and as volunteers for many events.

ON THE RUNWAY IN MILAN, ITALY

September. The expanded Complex is a renovation of the former Physical Activities Center and is home to USI Athletics and the Kinesiology and Sport Department. It houses multipurpose athletic courts, a large weight room and human performance lab, classrooms, locker rooms and study areas. The Aquatic Center is a nine-lane instructional and competitive pool which seats 190 spectators. In Fall 2022, it will welcome the first USI men's and women's intercollegiate swim and dive teams and bring the number of USI sports teams to 19.
