- 9. Assist with other RFW events as needed.
- 10. Check e-mail daily.
- 11. Complete other duties as assigned.

Time Commitment and Pay:

Position requires a commitment of 7-10 hours per week. Hours range from 7 pm - 11 pm $\,$. Working some evenings and weekends are required. Schedules are flexible to meet class schedules. Starting pay: \$7.25.
