Fresh Start Program

The Fresh Start program is designed to benefit former USI undergraduate students who are returning to the University after an extended absence and whose previous academic record was unsatisfactory (student was dismissed or on academic probation).

This program allows a readmitting student who wishes to complete an unfinished undergraduate degree a one-time opportunity to apply for a "Fresh Start." Students will be accepted into the program if they meet certain eligibility requirements. Immunization Requirement

The University has the obligation to protect the campus community from any potential contagious disease. Acceptable documentation consists of the following: Copy of your immunization records from high school or another postsecondary institution, physician's statement showing the month, day and year during which the vaccinations were administered or infection was experienced, completion of the USI Student Immunization form with doctor's signature, or personal record maintained by you or your family showing the month, day and year during which the vaccinations were administered.
