Provide one of the following documents that verify your status:

- Documentation from your high school or school district homeless liaison or designee.
- Documentation from the director or designee of an emergency or transitional shelter, street outreach program, homeless youth drop-in center, or other program serving individuals who are experiencing homelessness.
- Documentation from the director or designee of a program funded under subtitle B of title IV of McKinney-Vento (relating to emergency shelter grants).
- Documentation from the director or designee of a Federal TRIO program or a Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate program (GEAR UP) grant.
- Documentation from a financial aid administrator at your prior institution.

The documentation must verify that one of the above entities made the determination that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless on or after the date reported on FAFSA. The documentation must be signed and dated by the entity that made the determination.

If you are unable to provide the above documentation, you will need to complete and submit the Unaccompanied Homeless Youth Verification Form along with the requested documentation listed on the form. determination.
