Criteria	Description	Score (0-4)
Professional Accomplishments	Recognition of achievements in the field, such as notable projects, professional development, and advanced certifications.	
Roles in Radiography	Contribution to the field in terms of career achievements and clinical practice.	
Service	Involvement in the community, professional organizations, mentorship, the University, and outreach programs.	
Research and Innovation	Participation in research, development of new technologies, or approaches, and publications in reputable journals.	
Teaching / Training / Mentorship	Contributions to education and training in the field, such as mentoring, instructing, and educating radiography students.	
Leadership	Demonstrated leadership roles in professional organizations, initiatives, and projects.	

Scoring Guide:

4 – Excellent: Exceptional achievements or contributions in the specified area; significantly exceeds expectations.

3 – Very Good: Strong achievements or contributions in the specified area; exceeds expectations.

2 – Good: Satisfactory achievements or contributions in the specified area.

1 – Fair: Minimal achievements or contributions in the specified area; below expectations.

0 – Poor: No achievements or contributions in the specified area; far below expectations.
