

MAY 21, 2024 PEDIATRIC SANE INTENSIVE

This session is one-day intensive for registered nurses, advanced practice providers and physicians that provide care to prepubescent patients after sexual abuse. This course will offer a comprehensive review of pediatric anogenital anatomy, normal anogenital variants, the medical forensic examination process, forensic techniques and evidence collection procedures, non-acute medical examinations for child sexual abuse patients, documentation responsibilities as well as developing a plan of care and appropriate referrals. This course will also feature several case studies and mock scenarios to enhance learning.

This course will include 4 hours of an online pre-course self-study that will be available from April 22-May 21.
