# Shaw Biology Lecture on March 21

Please join us for the second annual Marlene V. Shaw Biology Lecture — this year, on Wednesday, March 21, at 7:00 p.m. in Carter Hall.

Ricki Lewis, a science writer with a doctorate in genetics from Indiana University-Bloomington, will speak on "Gene Therapy: A Forever Fix." Lewis is author of *Human Genetics: Concepts and Applications*, the most widely used college textbook in genetics, now in its 10<sup>th</sup> edition.

Her latest book, *Gene Therapy: A Forever Fix* (due from St. Martin's Press in early March), examines setbacks plaguing the treatment of rare genetic diseases as well as recent breakthroughs. According to Marlene, "Ricki is gifted at weaving stories and case studies in human genetics--she engages us not only with her knowledge of science, but also with her passion and compassion for individuals and their families whose stories she relates."
