Teams are expected to make an honest effort to follow the rules and the spirit of the problem (not interpret the rules so they have an unfair advantage). In particular, team members are expected to be the builders of all the devices used in the events. Failure by a participant, coach, or guest to abide by these codes, accepted safety procedures, or rules, may result in an assessment of penalty points or, in rare cases, disqualification by the tournament director from the event, the tournament, or future tournaments.
