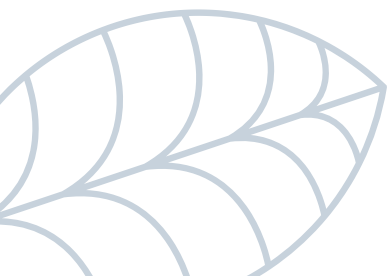

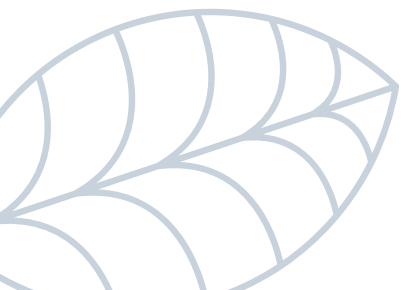

SAFETY TRAINING AT USI

Outreach and Engagement partners with the Tristate Industrial Safety Council, a member of the Association of Reciprocal Safety Councils (ARSC), to offer Basic Orientation Plus™ training programs. The mission of the Tristate Industrial Safety Council is to obtain a properly trained and safe contractor workforce and eliminate redundant orientations by providing consistent, cost-effective reciprocal safety education that conforms to regulatory standards and industry accepted practices. The Basic Orientation Plus training program meets most of the OSHA-mandated contractor requirements. As a result, the contract employee spends less time at the council on an annual basis and more time on the job. This increases safety training efficiency for the contract employee due to a reduction in redundant information being presented. Participants must register and pay for their safety course by 10 a.m. one business day prior to the class session. The registration fee is \$120 for Basic

Orientation Plus (BOP) and \$90 for the Basic Orientation Plus Refresher (BOPR). No refunds will be allowed for no-shows the day of training.

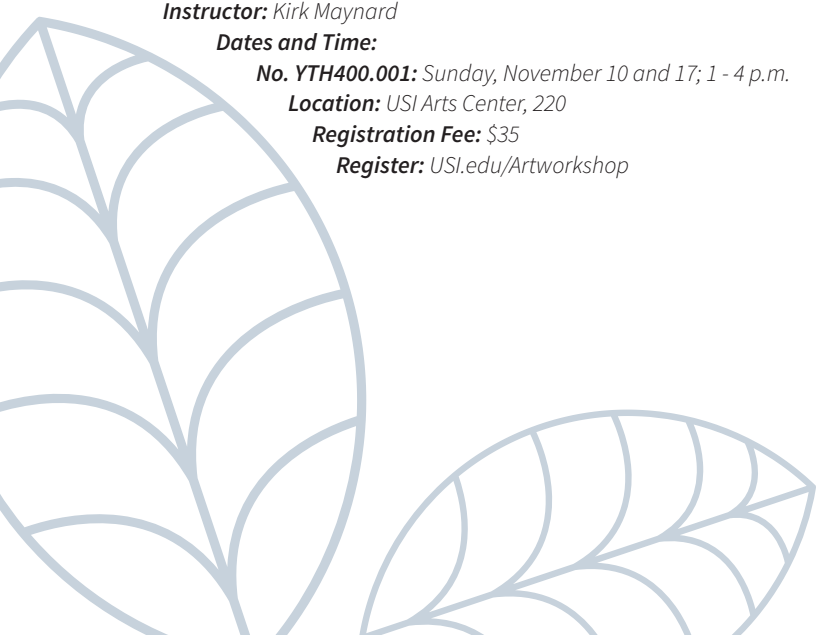

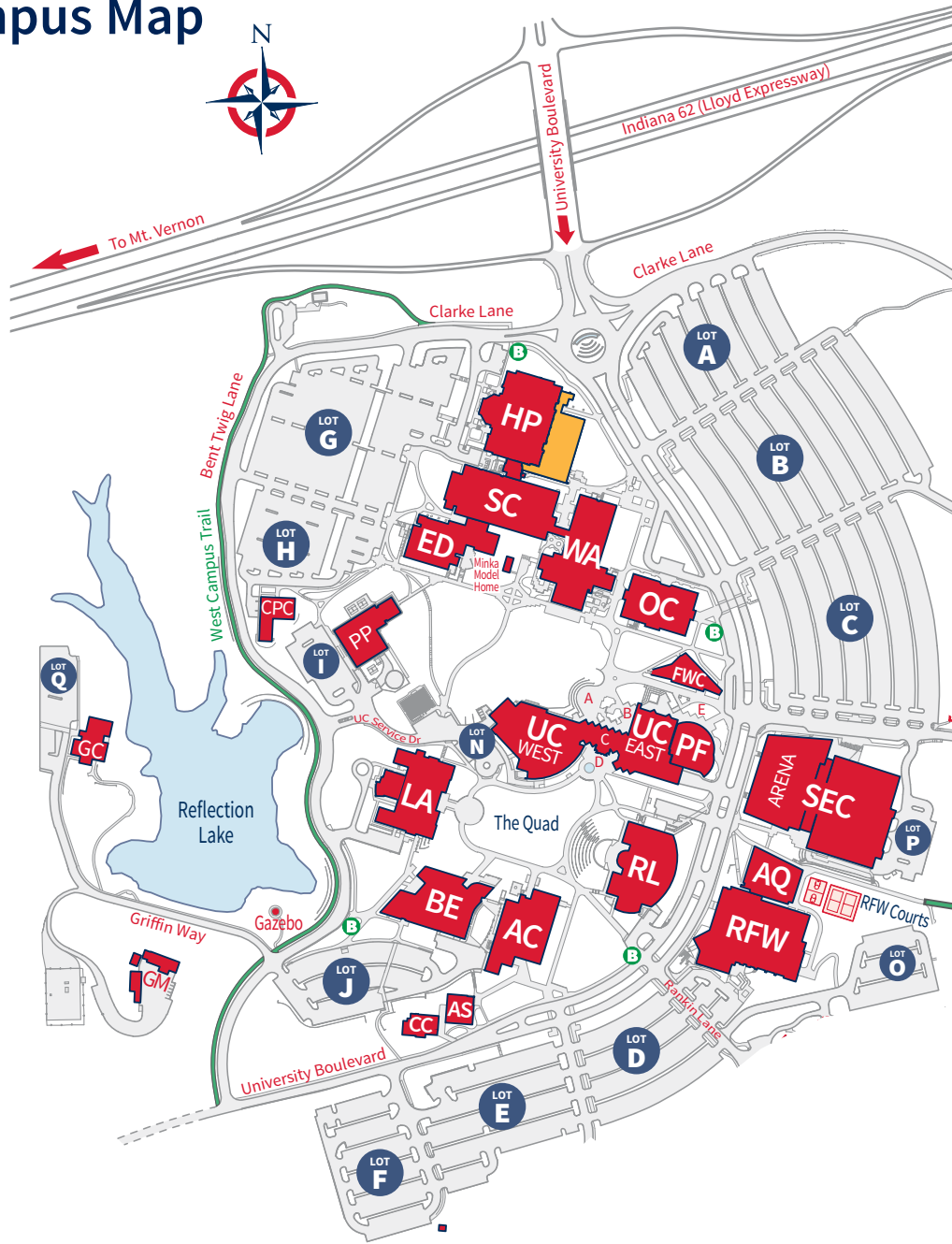
